**The Holy Father will Consecrate Russia
to the Immaculate Heart of Mary!**

The Vatican announced this on March 15, 2022. The Holy Father will preside at the Celebration of Penance at 17.00 (5:00 pm – Rome is 5 hours ahead, thus 12:00pm ET*) in Saint Peter's Basilica. The same act, on the same day, will be carried out in Fatima by His Eminence Cardinal Krajewski, Apostolic Almoner, as envoy of the Holy Father with our Bishops throughout the whole world.



March 25 is the Feast of the Annunciation – significance of March 25 - holy tradition says of this date: Adam and Eve were Created; the sacrifice of Isaac by his father Abraham; the passing of Israel through the Red Sea; St. John the Baptist's beheading; Jesus Died on Good Friday March 25th – The day that Mary took her Son's Body into Her Arms beneath the Cross, same day that She had taken His Body into Her Womb at the Annunciation; Feast of the Good Thief, St. Dismas, as Jesus Promised him from the Cross *"today you will be with Me in Paradise"*; Our Lady Announced to St. Bernadette at Lourdes that She is "The Immaculate Conception.

The news of the consecration follows a heartfelt appeal made on March 2 by the Latin-Rite Catholic bishops in Ukraine, who asked for the consecration of Russia and Ukraine "as requested by the Blessed Virgin in Fatima," to bring an end to the current conflict.

Their statement, released on the morning of Ash Wednesday, referenced the current conflict in Ukraine, and called for the consecration to be done in the manner requested by Our Lady of Fatima in 1917. The letter reads:

Holy Father! In these hours of immeasurable pain and terrible ordeal for our people, we, the bishops of the Episcopal Conference of Ukraine, are spokesmen for the unceasing and heartfelt prayer, supported by our priests and consecrated persons, which comes to us from all Christian people that Your Holiness will consecrate our Motherland and Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Responding to this prayer, we humbly ask Your Holiness to publicly perform the act of consecration to the Sacred Immaculate Heart of Mary of Ukraine and Russia, as requested by the Blessed Virgin in Fatima.

May the Mother of God, Queen of Peace, accept our prayer: Regina pacis, ora pro nobis!

In July 1917, Our Lady of Fatima gave the three visionaries this message, asking for the explicit consecration of Russia to her Immaculate Heart:

"To prevent this, I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the Communion of reparation on the First Saturdays. If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted, and there will be peace; if not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The good will be martyred; the Holy Father will have much to suffer; various nations will be annihilated.

In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me, and she shall be converted, and a period of peace will be granted to the world.”

Our Lady of Fatima repeated the request in 1929, when she appeared to Sr. Lucia saying:

“The moment has come for God to ask the Holy Father to make, in union with all the bishops of the world, the Consecration of Russia to My Immaculate Heart. By this means, He promises to save Russia.”

“Once I have Purged everything, I will place My Finger in a Surprising Way, and will give the True Peace. And then, all those who are humiliated will return to Me; and Germany will be Catholic – I have great designs upon her; England, Russia, and every place where blood was shed, will Rise Again to Faith and will be incorporated into My Church. There will be the Great Triumph and the union of peoples. Therefore, pray – and it takes patience, because this will not be so soon, but it will take time.”

“I have come to Fatima to pray, in union with Mary and so many pilgrims, for our human family, afflicted as it is by various ills and sufferings. Finally, I have come to Fatima with the same sentiments as those of Blessed Francisco and Jacinta, and the Servant of God Lúcia, in order to entrust to Our Lady the intimate confession that “I love” Jesus, that the Church and priests “love” him and desire to keep their gaze fixed upon him... and in order to entrust to Mary’s maternal protection...we would be mistaken to think that Fatima’s prophetic mission is complete.” Pope Benedict XVI - Shrine of Our Lady of Fátima – May 13, 2010
